The Opportunity

We are very proud of our pathways programs which enable athletes a transition point from Association based netball (State Age and Queensland Premier League) into broader regional representative netball to drive the competitiveness and depth of netball talent in Queensland. The primary purpose of this role is to assist and support the State Underage Head Coach in the development, management and delivery of a program and environment that facilitates the development of high performance behaviours, technical, tactical and psychological skills, on and off court that will contribute to the success of the individual athlete and Netball Queensland teams now and in the future.

The Role

The Assistant Coach – Queensland Underage Program (17U) will be responsible for the following:

- Work with the Head Coach and in consultation with the Campaign Manager on the development of an effective Campaign Plan that articulates appropriate goals, priority actions, milestones and risk awareness;
- Meet with the Head Coach prior to the commencement of the program to agree and establish guidelines and responsibilities for each role;
- Assist and support the Head Coach to deliver an appropriate training program for the team and individual players, including reinforcing performance behaviours and the establishment of a performance culture;
- Work closely in a spirit of partnership, and as agreed with the Head Coach to provide input into all aspects of the program; including but not limited to planning of sessions, training & competition plans, camps, debriefs, player feedback, reviews, management team meetings, starting line, substitutions, campaign plans;
- Provide support and input into the coaching of the team at all trainings and during the NNC;
- Assist with the review, analysis and communication of individual and team performance analysis;
- Assist the Head Coach with utilising the Athlete Management System to monitor player well-being, training loads and IAPPs;
- Ensure the program is conducted with the highest level of integrity;
- Promote the values, vision and culture of Netball Queensland;
- Ensure that player wellbeing is at the forefront of consideration in the delivery of the program;
- Work with the Head Coach to build positive relationships with Sapphire Series, Ruby Series or QPL coaches
 and facilitate open communication in relation to the management of players during periods of overlap
 between the two programs;
- Complete the Assistant Coach report for Netball Queensland within 14 days of the completion of the NNC
 and participate in all relevant Netball Queensland events, meetings, reviews, panels and engagements as
 agreed with the Performance Pathways Manager;
- Participate in the NQ coach development process for individual professional development; and
- Complete all other reasonable duties as identified and required to provide an elite performance environment to the Queensland Underage program and to assist the development of netball in Queensland.

The Assistant Coach – Queensland Underage Program will be required to attend the following:

- Squad/Team trainings, match play, training camps (commencing 30 January 2021);
- National Netball Championships (NNC) 3 11 July 2021;
- All meetings, including but not limited to debrief and performance analysis sessions as required by the Head Coach during the preparation phase and NNC;
- Relevant meetings as determined and required by NQ;
- Relevant camps, clinics or promotional activities as determined and required by NQ
- Relevant functions associated with the team as determined and required by NQ;
- Professional development sessions as determined and required by NQ;
- End of program review as determined and required by NQ.

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel may be required from time to time. Travel inter and intra state will also be required.

You must hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card prior to starting employment with Netball Queensland.

Your Experience and Skills

The Assistant Coach – Queensland Underage Program (17U) requires the following skills and experiences:

Qualifications and Experience

- National Coaching Advanced Accreditation or higher;
- Current Netball Queensland member;
- Possess a current Working with Children Blue Card;
- Current driver's license and vehicle;
- Current first aid training is advantageous;
- Previous coaching experience in an emerging elite and/or representative environment.

Knowledge and Skills

- Demonstrated success coaching emerging elite athletes and/or teams;
- Demonstrated ability to manage and deliver an effective training program to a team;
- Developing high level knowledge of technical, tactical requirements and decision making strategies at the underage level;
- Developing experience in the analysis of individual and team performances and how to enhance the performance of both during a game;
- Developing understanding and ability to review performance analysis footage to improve future performance;
- Developing understanding of the requirements to build a positive performance culture; and
- Demonstrates commitment and a willingness to be proactive in own development.

Personal Attributes

- Ability to develop rapport and effective working relationships with elite coaches, athletes, sports medicine staff and operational staff;
- Consultative, loyal and collaborative with a desire to support the Head Coach and the Campaign;
- Communication skills, including oral, written, negotiation skills, timely response to emails, and the ability to have the 'difficult conversations when required;
- Openness to feedback from the Campaign Manager and/or Head Coach, and self-awareness to implement changes based on feedback;
- Organised, with the ability to work under pressure, meet tight deadlines, and prioritise/delegate tasks;
- Values based decision maker;
- Developing ability to motivate and bring the best out in teams and individuals;
- Understands the requirement for confidentiality, impartiality and ethics;
- Willingness and ability to continue to develop relevant skills under the guidance of NQ.
- Commitment to NQ values; and
- Ability to work autonomously and effectively within a team environment.

What does success look like?

The role of Assistant Coach will be assessed on the following performance indicators:

- Agreed performance goals identified in the Campaign Plan are met;
- Player/team development is observable and supported via feedback across the course of the program;
- Team cohesiveness on and off the court is observable:
- Clarity of game plans and strategies is evident in the teams' performances on the court;

- Established effective working relationships with NQ Support staff, Sapphire Series, Ruby Series or QPL coaches and Underage Head Coach, ensuring a united front is presented to players/the team at all times;
- Assistant Coach is proactive in seeking opportunities to support and assist the Head Coach and extend own coaching skills, experience and capabilities;
- Head coach reports Assistant Coach was available and attended all meetings, trainings, matches and other sessions as required;
- Acceptable performance in undertaking the primary responsibilities assigned to this role;
- Loyalty and demonstrate solidarity with decisions made by the coaching, selection and Netball Queensland operational staff; and
- Demonstrated commitment to Netball Queensland values and adherence to all relevant Netball Queensland Codes and Policies.
