The Opportunity

The primary purpose of the 17 & Under State Team Head Coach is to select and develop the 17 & Under QLD State Team athletes and prepare the team for the National Netball Championships (tentatively scheduled for Term 1 school holidays April 3 - 13th 2022, location TBA.)

The Role

The key areas of responsibility 17 & Under State Team Head Coach, include but are not limited to:

- Liaise with the Netball Queensland High Performance Director, in regard to the physical preparation program for the athletes.
- Collaborate with players on building their individual athlete performance plans that identify key focus areas for development and outcomes for their campaign
- Collaborate with management team to develop a game style, establish team goals and timelines, outline a periodised training program, and establish roles and responsibilities.
- Liaise with service providers, physiotherapist, physical performance coach and Netball Queensland, regarding training schedule including dates, times and venue and any other requirements relating to training sessions e.g. Equipment.
- Provide leadership, communication and feedback to the Assistant and Apprentice Coaches.
- Submit to the Netball Qld Operational staff:
 - A full periodised training schedule,
 - Assistant and Apprentice Coach Program,
 - Outline the Outcomes and Key Results of the schedule and program.
- Liaise with relevant Selectors and Netball Queensland regarding injured athletes and/or alterations to the team from time of selection until departure for National Championships.
- Choose those athletes recommended as Team Captain and Vice Captain for submission by the Team Manager to the HPD prior to the Netball Australia team entry form closing date
- Oversee the preparation and match performance of the team throughout the relevant National Championships, providing individualized feedback to the players.
- At the conclusion of the National Championships complete the Coaches Survey and a written report within fourteen (14) days of the conclusion of the relevant National Championships.
- At the conclusion of the National Championship, attend an individual Performance Review with the HPD and another Netball Queensland representative

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel will be required from time to time. You <u>must</u> hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card prior to starting employment with Netball Queensland.
