- Target the needs of our young players and developing players by offering a unique, supportive environment that encourages teamwork, resilience, making new friends and having fun for long-term physical, psychological and social benefits
- Create a sense of community and fellowship within their association that will result in loyalty and commitment
- Provide development opportunities for coaches, umpires, managers and support staff to grow and strive towards their next challenge as an individual
- Deliver an experience to stimulate a life-long connection to netball
- Increase the number of athletes, coaches, umpires and officials staying in netball, progressing and transitioning within the Netball Queensland community and pathways
- Promote a culture of friendly competition, development and inclusivity
