- Refine the relationship between Netball Queensland and Queensland secondary schools to offer ongoing opportunities, support and school-based netball initiatives
- Provide a competition that gets the balance right between winning and developing
- Strive towards reducing the gap between male and female netball players by increasing exposure for male players and offering a progressive pathway
- Deliver an experience to stimulate a life-long connection to netball and provide long-term physical, psychological and social benefits
