


How to Enrol in Development Accreditation



1. Head to the Netball Learning learning management system [here](#).
2. If this is your first time logging into Netball Learning, follow the instructions on the right hand side. If you have logged in before, enter your Username and Password to log in again.

Congratulations in enrolling into the blended learning (online and face-to-face) Development Coach Accreditation. This course is targeted at Club, Association and Regional coaches and teachers aiming to further their netball knowledge. The Course is the second step in Netball Australia's Coach Accreditation Framework. It provides provides a good introduction to skill progression and fault detection and correction.

What you will learn

Once you have completed the course, you will have a good introduction to skill progression and fault detection and correction. In addition, other aspect of the course will include:

- Reviewing the **first five steps of the seven steps of skill progression**
- Applying the **steps of skill progression** within a practical environment/activity
- Safely teaching, identifying and correcting technique faults in netball for;
 1. ball handling skills
 2. movement and footwork skills
 3. attacking skills
 4. defending skills
 5. goal shooting / circle defence skills
- Creating and progressing appropriate **skills sessions** into dynamic situations
- Creating and evaluating simple **Game Day** team goals and strategies
- Applying the techniques of basic netball skills into relevant court situations
- Employing four of the **self-reflection methods** to evaluate and improve the quality of coach management, teaching and communication.

The course will also assist you to deliver a practical coaching session where you will:

- Attend a **face-to-face workshop** where you can practice what you learn in a training environment.
- Learn how to **Develop a session plan**.
- Complete a **coaching self-assessment** on yourself after conducting a session you have developed.

Netball Australia Accreditations expire **4 years** from the date obtained and to maintain the accreditation you must complete the reaccreditation pathway and achieve **40 development points** prior to the accreditation expiry date. Netball Australia allows a 6-month grace period to complete the reaccreditation pathway and your accreditation expire.

8. Once you have completed the Development Coach Online Course, you can do the Development sessions Practical Coach Workshop. Repeat steps three-six, instead clicking on the 'Development Coach Online Course' option from the course library.




