


How to Enrol in Foundation Accreditation

August 2022

1. Head to the Netball Learning learning management system [here](#).
2. If this is your first time logging into Netball Learning, follow the instructions on the right hand side. If you have logged in before, enter your Username and Password to log in again.

This course is designed for beginner coaches, teachers, parents and NetSetGO coaches and offers introductory coaching information and teaches basic netball techniques.

What you will learn

Once you have completed the course, you will have a well rounded understanding of netball coaching, including:

- Identifying the **roles and responsibilities** of the coach
- Understanding the **social development** considerations for why children play sport
- Understanding the benefits of using a **game sense approach** to teach game concepts and develop long term learning
- Understanding the importance of **effective group management** skills to maximise opportunities for successful participation
- Understanding the **planning and review process**
- Utilising **effective communication techniques** to develop player understanding of the basic skills of netball
- Identifying **skill faults and correct technique** for the basic skills of netball

Netball Australia Accreditations expiry **4 years** from the date obtained and to maintain the accreditation and you must complete the reaccreditation pathway and achieve **20 development points** prior to the accreditation expiry date. Netball Australia allow 6-month grace period to complete the reaccreditation pathway prior to our accreditation expire.

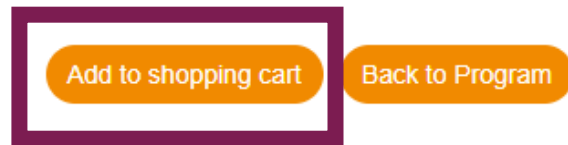

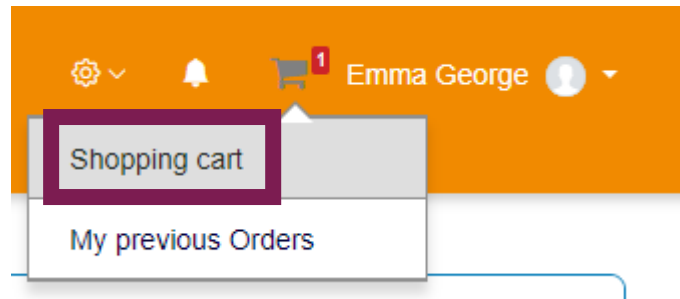
8. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click 'Add to Shopping Cart'. This will refresh your page, and when you scroll to the top of the page, you can now see a number 1 next to the shopping cart icon on the right-hand side of the main menu.

9. Click on the shopping cart icon, and then click on the 'Shopping Cart' option from the dropdown menu. This will take you to Netball Australia's payment portal. Here, you need to follow the on-screen instructions to purchase the course just like you would with any other online shopping experience.



10. Once the payment process is finished, you will be redirected back to the Netball Learning site. You can now complete the Foundation Online Coach Course.
11. For your Foundation Coach Accreditation to be valid, you must also complete the Rules of Netball Exam with a grade of 70.00% or higher. To complete the Rules of Netball Exam, follow steps three-five, instead searching for 'Rules of Netball' in the search bar, and then steps 8-10 to purchase the course.
