


How to Enrol in Intermediate Accreditation

August 2022

1. Head to the Netball Learning learning management system [here](#).
2. If this is your first time logging into Netball Learning, follow the instructions on the right hand side. If you have logged in before, enter your Username and Password to log in again.

This course is designed to enhance your knowledge of coaching at Representative, Talent Identification and Metro/Regional League level.

The course is the third step in the Netball Australia National Coaching Accreditation Framework and will provide you with an understanding and application of the first skill progressions.

What you will learn

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Identify the coaching points relating to the identified skill and **detect the common faults**
- **Plan, organise, conduct** and control a skills session
- Demonstrate the concept of **sequential skill progression**
- Demonstrate the concepts behind the **detection and correction of faults**
- Describe when to use a **coachable moment**
- Provide appropriate and relevant **feedback** during practical sessions

You will also be required to attend a face to face workshop where you will undertake:

- Completion of worksheets across the face-to-face workshop.
- Development of a session plan.
- Practical Coaching task.

Netball Australia Accreditations expire **4 years** from the date obtained and to maintain the accreditation you must complete the reaccreditation pathway and achieve **60 development points** prior to the accreditation expiry date. Netball Australia allows a 6-month grace period to obtain these points should your accreditation expire.

- Identify preferred teaching methods and coaching styles to develop the intermediate skills of Netball
- Demonstrate effective communication strategies
- Identify the coaching points relating to the identified skill and detect the common faults
- Plan, organise, conduct and control a skills session
- Demonstrate an awareness of safety in terms of equipment and players
- Demonstrate the concept of sequential skill progression
- Demonstrate the concepts behind the detection and correction of faults
- Describe when to use a coachable moment
- Provide appropriate and relevant feedback during practical sessions
- Understand the role of the mentor coach and establish practical strategies to enhance individual coaching.

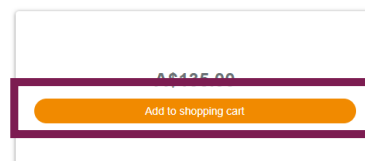

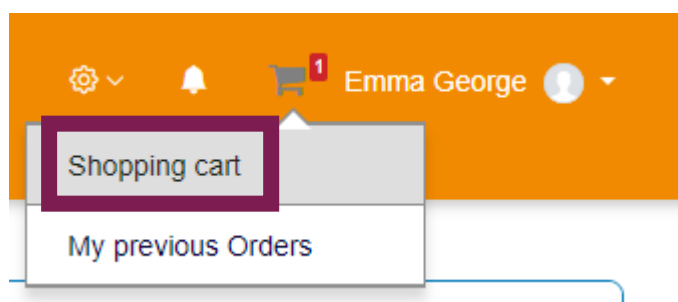
About the course

The Intermediate Coaching course is the third step in the Netball Australia coaching accreditation framework. It is aimed at coaches of Association representative teams. The course focuses on continuing the development of player skills and session planning. It also provides ways to enhance player performance through error identification and providing corrective feedback.

What are the requirements of the course?
