Your Contribution to Netball Queensland

The primary purpose of the QFFA Assistant Coach is to provide assistance and support to the QFFA Head Coach during the preparation phase and during competition at the Australian Netball Championships. The QFFA Assistant Coach will assist the Head Coach with developing and implementing training sessions and match strategies which will deliver a competitive game plan during the championship. The assistant coach as directed by the head coach will provide feedback to athletes to assist with performance.

Key Responsibilities of this role

The Qld Firebirds Futures Assistant Coach will be responsible for the following:

- Assist the Qld Firebirds Futures Head Coach in the delivery of a 10-week campaign (April to June) plan
 which will deliver emerging athletes with technical and tactical development and an opportunity to
 experience high quality competition
- Assist with the design and delivery of technical and tactical coaching sessions and match play opportunities
- Assist with the delivery of specified activation exercises and team warmups where directed and when the physical performance coach is unable to do so
- Assist with communicating and reinforcing team goals, values and behaviours
- Assist in providing feedback to athletes during training and match play
- Assist with performance analysis of opposition athletes and opposition teams and provide input on areas of strength and weakness
- Utilize performance analysis to provide and support feedback to athletes
