The Starting Seven Impact Initiatives

Your investment will directly impact and contribute to the delivery of the following initiatives each year:

Remote First Nations Netball Queensland Delivery Program - Diamond Spirit Engage

- NQ Staff member to travel to remote Indigenous communities to deliver entry level experiences in netball, provide upskilling for sustainability of programs and provide community equipment pack.
- Potential trip locations:
 - Cooktown, Wujal Wujal, Hopevale
 - Kowanyama, Pormpuraaw, Coen
 - Lockhart, Aurukun, Weipa, Naprannum, Old Mapoon

- Thursday Island, Torres Strait Island, Northern Peninsular Area
- Mt Isa, Cloncurry and Dajarra

Regional and Remote Coaching and Development Program

- Development of new digital offering to provide expert training and development opportunities for coaches in regional and remote areas. On-line course to include regular webinar and development check ins with NQ staff.
 - This program ensures emerging netballers outside of SEQ can access high quality development opportunities from the best netball coaches in the country.

The Starting Seven Impact Initiatives

Regional Talent Combines

- Open invitationals for regional netballers to attend. Netball Queensland to send the best staff in the pathways and high performance to conduct and oversee evidence-based performance testing.
 - This program will support the development program and ensure that all netballers, anywhere in Queensland, have the opportunity to be talent identified.

NQ Wellbeing Officer Program

- To continue to be a safe space for women and girls, NQ to implement the statewide Wellbeing Officer program in Associations. Funding support enables delivery of Wellbeing Officer packs to all 83 associations with supporting collateral and facilitation of community of practice initiatives.
 - The program provides education, support and professional development opportunities for the Wellbeing Officers.



The Investment

Investment of \$55K + GST per annum over three years into the Netball Queensland Future of Netball Development Fund.

• \$50K of the funds to be donated via the <u>Australian Sports</u> <u>Foundation</u> attracting a 100% tax deduction

Other benefits
