Umpire Your Own

Schools are required to supply one umpire per team registered. Primary Schools Cup will apply *umpire your own.*Umpire allocations are the responsibility of the School and the teams.

Finals Series Umpire Allocations

Netball Queensland's Umpire Coordinator will select the umpires for the Finals Series for all divisions; Championship (Division 1), Challenge (Division 2) and Development (Division 3). Umpires selected for the Finals Series will be based on their performance throughout the weekend.

Netball Queensland's Umpire Coordinator reserves the right to make umpire allocations outside of the 'umpire your own' format. This is to ensure umpire capability aligns with particular matches during the competition.

Umpire Payments

It is the School and Umpires' responsibility to arrange appropriate payment with their nominated umpire. Please discuss this payment arranagement before the competition to avoid any unforeseen issues during or after the event.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

Day 1 - Preliminary Rounds

Teams have been allocated into Preliminary Pools based on the School's results from 2024 and geographical locations.

Championship (Division 1) Division

- 35 Teams
- 6 Pools
- 5 Pools of 6 Teams, 1 Pool of 5 Teams

Challenge (Division 2) Division

- 29 Teams
- 4 Pools
- 3 Pools of 7 Teams, 1 Pool of 8 Teams

Development (Division 3) Division

- 20 Teams
- 4 Pools
- 2 Pools of 7 Teams, 1 Pool of 6 Teams

During the Preliminary Rounds, teams will play all teams within their pool once. After the pool games have been played, teams will move into Playoffs to determine final placings. All teams will be re-graded at the conclusion of Day 1. Schools will receive notification via Netball Connect once the Playoff Divisions & Draw (Day 2 Divisions & Draw) are available. Schools will also receive an email from competitions@netballq.org.au when this has been published Saturday evening.

Team Rankings for the Playoffs will be determined by:

- 1. Ladder Position within your Preliminary Pool
- 2. Points at the conclusion of the Preliminary Rounds
- 3. In the event of a tie on points at the completion of the Preliminary Round matches, positions will be decided by goal percentage achieved by each team highest to lowest (i.e. goals for divided by goals against multiplied by 100). This will automatically calculate on Netball Connect.
- 4. If two (2) teams are tied according to goal percentage to two (2) decimal points, the result of the match between the two (2) teams concerned during the rounds will decide the winner.
- 5. In the event of a further tie, the team scoring the most goals will secure the higher-ranking position.

Day 2 - Playoffs & Final Placings

Based on the results from Day 1, teams will be re-graded into new pools for Day 2. The structure for the Playoff Pools are outlined in this document.

Finals

Championship Playoff 1-6, Challenge Playoff 1-8 and Development Playoff 1-6 teams are the **only** teams in contention for the Grand Finals.

Grand Finals - Position 1 on the Ladder v Position 2 on the Ladder Championship (Division 1) Grand Final - 3:55pm, COURT 1 Challenge (Division 2) Grand Final - 3:55pm, COURT 2

Development (Division 3) Grand Final - 3:55pm, COURT 3

The Grand Final matches are in addition to the round-robin matches on Day 2, and will generate on Netball Connect at the conclusion of the relevant Playoff Divisions round-robin matches.

Grand Final matches will enter Extra Time if scores are drawn at full-time. The following will occur:

- 1. There will be a one (1) minute interval at the end of full-time, during which teams may make substitutions and/or changes.
- 2. The Centre Pass is taken by the team entitled to take the next Centre Pass.
- 3. There will be no stoppages for injury/illness, and the player concerned must be removed from the court, if safe to do so.
- 4. During Extra Time, there will be two (2) four (4) minute halves. If scores are still tied at the end of extra-time, the match will enter *Extended Extra Time* and play will continue until one (1) team has a two (2) point advantage.

VENUE INFORMATION

School Tent City

Schools Bump-In is Friday 19th September, 3pm to 4.30pm.

These are fixed times, and will not be adjusted for any School.

Schools that arrive earlier will be told to return during the bump-in period.

All tents/marquees must be pegged or weighted.

The Schools Tent City map is included in this document. All tents and sites will be marked on the field.

Netball Queensland Staff will be around the site to direct Schools and Parents where to set-up.

Parent Tent City

Parent Tent City is Friday 19th September, 3pm to 4.30pm.

These are fixed times, and will not be adjusted for any Parents/Guardians or Supporters.

Parents that arrive earlier will be told to return during the bump-in period.

All tents/marquees must be pegged or weighted.

The Parent Tent City map is included in the Venue Map.

Netball Queensland Staff will be around the site to direct Schools and Parents where to set-up.

Keep Your Valuables Safe

We would like to remind all attendees to keep their belongings safe during the event. Security will be on-site overnight for the duration of the event, however we cannot guarantee the safety of personal items. Valuables should **not** be left in tents overnight. If you do so, it is at your own risk.

Hydration Stations & Catering

Water hydration stations will be available at the venue for all patrons to refill water bottles. Bottled water will be available at the canteen and from the food vendors.

Teams are welcome to provide their own catering. Alternatively, food will be available to purchase at the canteen and food vendors on-site.

Ice

There will be one (1) opportunity daily for teams to collect their pre-purchased ice at the venue:

• 7.30am - 8.30am: Saturday & Sunday

Ball

There will be one (1) opportunity for teams to collect their Netball Queensland match ball at the venue:

7:30am - 8:30am: Saturday ONLY

What NOT To Bring

For safety reasons, barbecues and portable toilets are not permitted to be brought on-site by patrons.

Car & Bus Parking

Free parking is available within the Underwood Park and Recreation Complex. Street parking is also available on Underwood Road and the side streets. Traffic Control will be on-site each morning to assist with parking and player/bus drop-off. If your School requires on-site bus parking, please email competitions@netballq.org.au by COB Friday 5th September.

First Aid & Strapping

First Aid will be on-site for the duration of the competition. If your team requires medical assistance, please visit the First Aid room or ask a Court Marshall to radio for a First Aid Officer.

Strappers will be on-site on both days of the competition from 7:00am to 10:00am. If participants wish to receive strapping, they MUST bring their own tape. Tape will be available for purchase from the HART Sport tent in the Chill-Out Zone.

Please note - in the event of an emergency, no one other than Netball Queensland officials or the Netball Queensland Sports Medicine Personnel are to call for an ambulance and to advise safe entry in to the venue. This is important to ensure multiple ambulances are not called for the same incident.
