As Head Coach, you will also play an important part in leading the Firebirds Futures team in the Super Netball Reserves Competition, helping to shape the team environment and contributing to the planning and delivery of the program. Our aim is to create a positive, high-quality training and performance experience for all involved.

This role provides a valuable opportunity to contribute to the growth of talented athletes across Queensland, while playing a key part in nurturing the next generation of Firebirds.

Key Responsibilities of this role

The purpose of the QLD Firebirds Futures Head Coach role is to develop identified emerging athletes with the skills necessary to perform in training and to compete in the Super Netball Reserves competition. The key areas of responsibility include:

- Design and deliver specialist coaching sessions and a periodised program with the Physical Performance Coach
- Complete athlete individual athlete performance plans (IAPPs) and review at the conclusion of the program
- Monitor through AMS the athlete daily training environment that will contribute to the athlete's development
- Identify, develop and deliver, or arrange the delivery of targeted educational opportunities such as leadership, high performance behaviours, cultural understanding, communication, social media and wellbeing
- Select and coach the Firebirds Futures Team at the SNR competition
- Design and deliver technical and tactical coaching sessions and match play opportunities
- Collaborate with the Head of Talent and Development / Firebirds Futures Assistant Coach on the design and delivery of training sessions
- Monitor through AMS the athlete daily training environment
- Liaise with HPNL Coaches to manage athlete load

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel will be required from time to time. You <u>must</u> hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card.
