You will be able to positively collaborate and work with key stakeholders to support their athletes throughout the campaign to ensure they are physically and emotionally prepared to give their best performance for QLD at the Marie Little Shield.

Key Responsibilities of this role

The Queensland Gems State Team Assistant Coach will be responsible for the following:

- Work with the Diversity & Inclusion Manager and Queensland Gems State Team Head Coach with the development of an effective Campaign Plan that articulates appropriate goals, priority actions, and key outcomes
- Meet with the Head Coach prior to the commencement of the program to agree and establish guidelines and responsibilities for each role;
- Assist and support the Head Coach to deliver a training program developing technical and tactical skills for individual athletes and the team
- Assist and support the Head Coach to reinforce team culture, vision, purpose and high-performance standards and expectations for the team
- Assist and the support the Head Coach in the delivery of all aspects of the program including training and competition plans, bonding days, training debriefs, athlete feedback, and team management meetings
- Provide support and input into the game day coaching of the team during the Marie Little Shield
- Assist with the review of game day performance to provide feedback to the Head Coach
- Promote the values, vision and culture of Netball Queensland.
- Complete the Assistant Coach report for Netball Queensland within 14 days of the completion of the Marie Little Shield
- Participate in all relevant Netball Queensland events, meetings, reviews, panels and engagements as agreed with the Diversity & Inclusion Manager
- Perform other reasonable duties as outlined by NQ

The QLD Gems State Team Assistant Coach is required to attend:

- Campaign program planning meetings
- Selection trials associated with the squad/team where appropriate

- All squad/team training sessions (commencing March 2026)
- 2026 Marie Little Shield (September- Date and Location TBC)
- Represent NQ at key functions associated with the team
- Professional development sessions offered by NQ

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel will be required from time to time. You **must** hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card prior to starting engagement with Netball Queensland.

Qualifications, Knowledge, Competencies and Experience

- Current Blue Card

Knowledge, experience and skills

- Experience working with athletes with an intellectual disability in a similar role
- Understanding of athletes with a disability, their behaviours and reasonable adjustments required.
- A minimum of 2 years coaching
- Understanding of the fundamental coaching principles
- Demonstrated excellent written and verbal communications skills
- Problem solver - high resilience and a growth mindset. Can analyze problems and likes to be challenged
- Ability to positively nurture and show empathy to athletes to support and grow their understanding of what physical and personal characteristics are required in a high performance environment
- Ability to educate and mentor developing athletes on the technical and tactical skills required for their positional role

Blue Card

As an organisation we are committed to protecting children and young people from harm. It is essential that anyone employed at NQ understand their responsibility in relation to child safety.
