Key Responsibilities of this role

The QLD Gems State Team Development Coach will be responsible for the following:

- Meet with the Head Coach prior to the commencement of the program to agree and establish guidelines and responsibilities for your role
- Assist Head Coach in the delivery of all aspects (as agreed) of the program which may include training, bonding days, training debriefs, athlete feedback, and team management meetings
- Assist and support the Head Coach to reinforce team culture, vision, purpose and high-performance standards and expectations for the team
- Promote the values, vision and culture of Netball Queensland
- Participate in all relevant Netball Queensland events, meetings, reviews, panels and engagements as agreed with the Diversity & Inclusion Manager
- Perform all other duties as are reasonably required by NQ

The QLD Gems State Team Development Coach is required to attend:

- Program planning meetings as required by the Head Coach
- Selection trials associated with the squad/team where appropriate and as required by the Head Coach
- All squad/team training sessions as required by the Head Coach (Commencing March 2026)
- Professional development sessions offered by Netball Queensland
- Review meetings as required

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel will be required from time to time. You <u>must</u> hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card prior to starting employment with Netball Queensland.

- Understanding of the fundamental coaching principles.
- Strong commitment to learning and developing in their role as coach
- Experience in working in a team environment, including collaborating with other coaches, staff and volunteers.
- High level of interpersonal skills

Blue Card
