Your Contribution to Netball Queensland

The primary purpose of the QLD Gems State Team Head Coach is to select and develop the QLD Gems State Team athletes and prepare the team for competition at the Marie Little Shield.

The Marie Little Shield is an annual National tournament for Women and Girls with an intellectual impairment. More information about the Queensland Gems and Marie Little Shield can be found here: Queensland Gems - Netball Queensland

It is your responsibility to guide and nurture them in understanding the high-performance characteristics required for them to develop in technical / tactical skill and game performance.

You will be able to positively collaborate and influence key stakeholders to support their athletes throughout the campaign to ensure they are physically and emotionally prepared to give their best performance for QLD at the Marie Little Shield.

Key Responsibilities of this role

The Queensland Gems State Team Head Coach will be responsible for the following:

- Collaborate with Netball Queensland (NQ) and Queensland Gems support staff to select the Queensland Gems Team.
- Collaborate with NQ and the management team to develop a clear campaign plan, establish team goals, key outcomes, and clarity on team roles and responsibilities
- Liaise with relevant NQ staff and Gems support staff to prepare training program to support the teams game plan
- Collaborate with athletes to develop their individual athlete performance plans for clarity on individual goals and outcomes where applicable.
- Liaise and provide advice to coaches, managers, team support staff, and NQ regarding training schedule including dates, times, venues, and education required
- Work in collaboration with Regional Queensland Gems Academy Coaches to ensure alignment across programs.
- Provide direction on the education provided to athletes during the preparation phase
- Provide leadership, communication and direction to the Assistant Coaches on their role and the duties they will perform to support the Head Coach
- Liaise with NQ regarding injured athletes and/or alterations to the team from time of selection until departure for the Marie Little Shield
- Manage and supervise athletes and team staff within the QLD Gems, ensuring positive team behaviours and culture as well as adherence to relevant policies, processes and protocols
- Conduct a process to select the captain and vice-captains to lead the QLD Gems State Team
- Oversee the preparation and match performance of the team throughout the Marie Little Shield

- Provide feedback to athletes throughout the Marie Little Shield on direction and clarity on their technical and tactical skill and game performance
- At the conclusion of the Marie Little Shield complete the Coaches Survey and a written report within fourteen (14) days
- At the conclusion of the Marie Little Shield attend an individual review with the Diversity and Inclusion Manager
- Perform other duties as reasonably required by NQ

The QLD Gems State Team Head Coach is required to attend:

- Campaign program planning meetings
- Selection trials associated with the squad/team
- All squad/team training sessions (commencing March 2026)
- 2026 Marie Little Shield (September- date and location TBC)
- Represent NQ at key functions associated with the team
- Professional development sessions offered by NQ
- End of program review as determined by NQ

Due to the nature of the position and the sport industry, evening, weekend work and travel will be required from time to time. You <u>must</u> hold a Working with Children (Blue) Card prior to starting employment with Netball Queensland.

Qualifications, Knowledge, Competencies and Experience

The QLD Gems State Team Head Coach requires the following qualifications and experiences:

Qualifications

- Current Blue Card
- Current Drivers Licence
- Minimum Intermediate Coach accreditation
- Relevant First Aid qualification

Knowledge, experience and skills

- Experience working with athletes with an intellectual disability in a similar role
- Understanding of athletes with a disability, their behaviours and any reasonable adjustments required.
- A minimum of 2 years coaching in a state, emerging elite or elite environment
- Understand the requirement for confidentiality, impartiality and ethics
- Demonstrated success coaching state, elite or emerging elite teams and athletes
- Ability to positively nurture and show empathy to athletes to support and grow their understanding of what physical and personal characteristics are required in a high performance environment
- Ability to educate and mentor developing athletes on the technical and tactical skills required in their positional role
- Ability to educate and mentor developing coaches within the program
- Demonstrated excellent written and verbal communications skills
- Problem solver high resilience and a growth mindset. Can analyze problems and likes to be challenged.

Other Information

Blue Card

As an organisation we are committed to protecting children and young people from harm. It is essential that anyone employed at NQ understand their responsibility in relation to child safety.
