Your Contribution to Netball Queensland

The primary purpose of the Queensland Gems Team Manager is to lead and deliver all logistical operations of the training schedule for the QLD Gems state team. You will provide support to the Head Coach and athletes to ensure the smooth logistical delivery of the training schedule.

You will be able to positively collaborate and influence key stakeholders to support their athletes throughout the campaign to ensure they are physically and emotionally prepared to give their best performance for Queensland at the Marie Little Shield Tournament.

In addition to on-court performance for the QLD Gems State Team in the Marie Little Shield, success in this role will be measured by player, families and management team feedback survey and general logistical efficiency of the campaign.

The Marie Little Shield is an annual National tournament for Women and Girls with an intellectual impairment. More information about the Queensland Gems and Marie Little Shield can be found here: Queensland Gems - Netball Queensland

Key Responsibilities of this role

The Queensland Gems State Team Manager will be responsible for the following:

- Coordinate all off-court team operations and logistics including but not limited to any training sessions and match day requirements
- Build and maintain positive relationships and communication with coaches, support staff, athletes, NQ operational staff and parents/guardians/carers.
- Ensure early completion of Sports Integrity Australia framework education to champion the required behaviours of staff and squad/team with regards to anti-doping fundamentals, competition betting and manipulation, child safeguarding, harassment and discrimination, and ethics in sport
- Attend all team meetings, training sessions, functions and events and perform duties including
 ensuring athletes and staff are aware of, and adhere to, relevant uniform, behaviour standards and
 understand where to find NQ policies
- In collaboration with the Head Coach prepare run sheets for all trainings and team bonding days
- Assist with ensuring the prompt return of team documentation such as NQ or NA Athlete agreements,
 Medication Consent forms and any other key documentation.
- Where required, provide athlete supervision/child safeguarding practices during training, or education sessions
- Encourage athlete/parent/guardian/carer understanding and consistent use of communication platforms.
- Support the accurate ordering of team uniforms
- Ensure appropriate rooming and pack lists are developed and implemented for all away trips

- In consultation with NQ Diversity & Inclusion Manager and support staff devise menu plan appropriate for performance and recovery at the Marie Little Shield Tournament.
- Communicate key information regarding the logistics and operations of the Marie Little Shield to relevant athletes, support staff and parents/guardians/carers
- Ensure the prompt registration of the team on Netball Connect or the relevant registration platform used for the Marie Little Shield Tournament
- Prior to the Marie Little Shield research the host venue, including places of interest, medical facilities, close to accommodation and provide relevant information to athletes and parents/guardians/carers
- In collaboration with the Head Coach prepare a weekly and daily run sheets for the Marie Little Shield
- Ensure the team and staff follow required timelines/run sheets on travel and game days
- In collaboration with the Head Coach ensure appropriate team management meetings take place throughout the campaign and each day of the Marie Little Shield to communicate any changes to schedule or athlete management
- Ensure full compliance of all athletes and staff with the NQ and NA integrity framework
- Ensure that relevant budgets are maintained and brought in under budget
- Maintain appropriate financial records and provide a reconciliation report as required for travel expenses
- Report any matters of misconduct directly to Netball Queensland
- At the conclusion of the Marie Little Shield complete the Manager Survey and a written report within fourteen (14) days
- At the conclusion of the Marie Little Shield attend an individual EOY review with NQ Staff
- Perform other duties as reasonably required by NQ.

The QLD Gems State Team Manager is required to attend the following:

- Squad / team selection and trainings, team days, match play (Commencing March 2026)
- Marie Little Shield (timings to be confirmed anticipated travel in September)
- All meetings, including but not limited to debrief sessions as required by the Head Coach during the preparation phase and Marie Little Shield
- Relevant meetings as determined and required by NQ
- Professional development sessions as determined by NQ
- End of program review as determined and required by NQ

- Experience working with athletes with an intellectual disability in a similar role

- High level interpersonal skills and the ability to elicit the cooperation of people
- Proven ability to develop strong internal and external relationship with key stakeholders

- Understand the requirement for confidentiality, impartiality and ethics
- Ability to set priorities, operational plans and timelines and to meet deadlines
- Team player with the ability to work autonomously or under minimal supervision and meet deadlines
- Excellent communication skills inclusive of high-level writing skills and ability to interface through all mediums
- Problem solver high resilience and a growth mindset. Can analyze problems and likes to be challenged.
