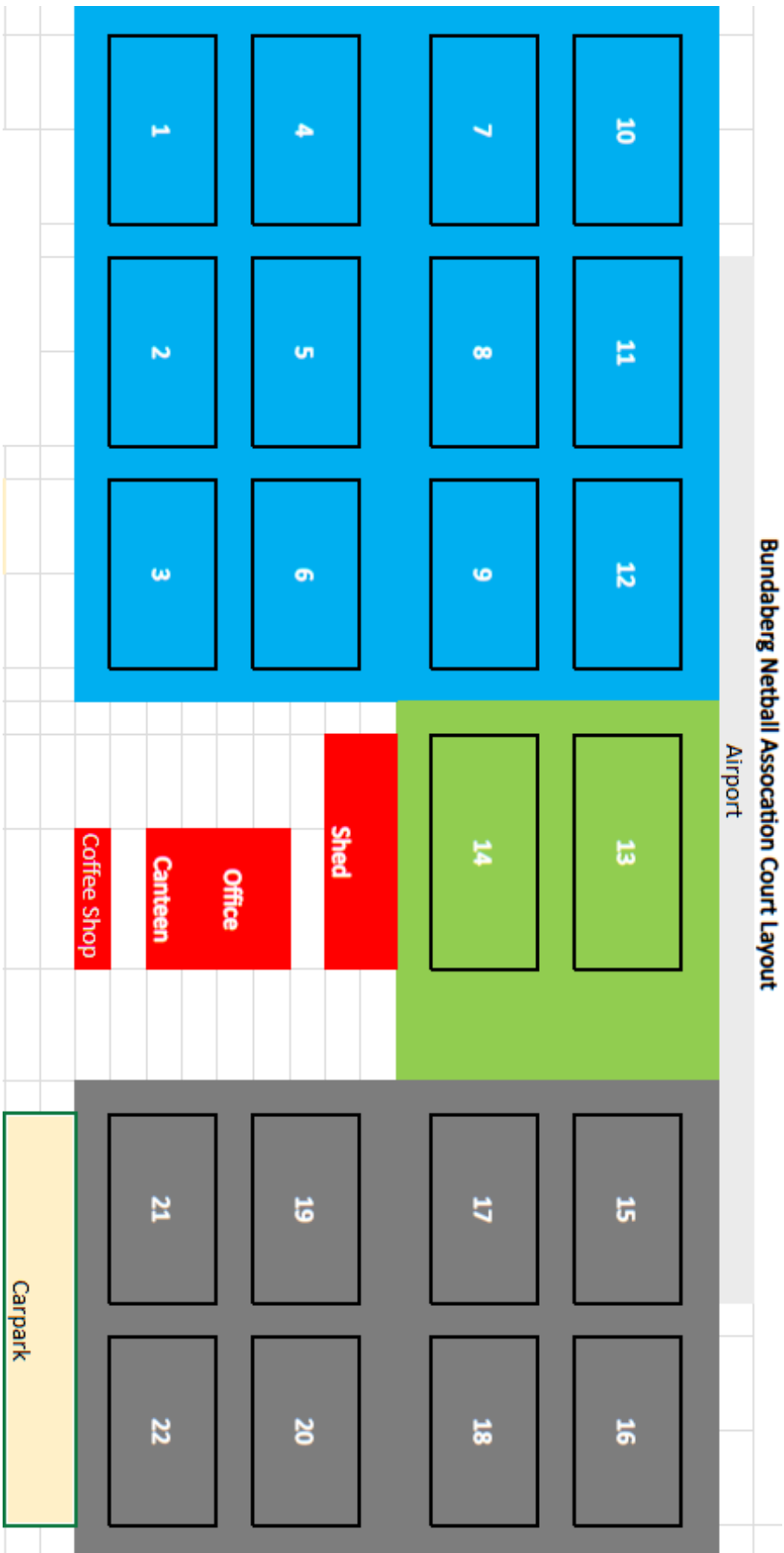
All teams must submit a completed team list prior to the commencement of the preliminary round.

A copy of the team list template has been provided.

PRELIMINARY ROUND RULES:

1. In order for a school's team to be eligible for the preliminary round, they MUST supply ONE UMPIRE PER TEAM. The umpire cannot be a student playing in a team and one umpire cannot umpire more than one team. In the event of a team participating in a game without providing an umpire the team will be forced to forfeit the game with the score being recorded as "10-0" against the forfeiting team. However, the game may still take place.
2. All players from one team must wear the same netball uniform.
3. Schools should ensure that they have two sets of different coloured bibs at all matches to overcome the problem of schools having uniforms that too closely resemble each other. In such an event, a coin toss prior to the match will determine the team that will choose the colour of bib they will wear.
4. **Games will be scored using LiveScoring on Netball Connect.**
5. Each team must supply one (1) scorer for each game, who is to position themselves with the opposing team's scorer for the duration of the match.
6. It will be the listed HOME team's responsibility to score the games using NetballConnect and the AWAY team's responsibility to monitor the scoreboard (if applicable).
7. Coaches and Scorers for the game will be required to confirm the scores at the completion of the game.
8. A qualified First Aid Officer will be present at the Preliminary Round. Refer to map provided as to where they are located.
9. Preliminary Round is centrally timed – no injury time will be added.
10. Rolling substitutions apply: a player may substitute at any time, as long as they step off the court to do so. Time will not be held for rolling substitutions.
11. The duration of the Preliminary Round matches is at the discretion of Netball Queensland and the Regional Coordinator/s, based on the number of teams entered in the region and court availability.
12. NO JEWELLERY is allowed. All fingernails are to be cut short. Soft brim hats permitted.
13. All games will comprise of 10-minute halves with 2 minutes for half time and 3-minutes between each game.
14. 2 points will be awarded for a win, 1 for a draw and 0 for a loss.
15. Games will commence at 8:00am and finish at 3:55pm.
16. If teams are on equal points at the end of preliminary rounds, the following rules will be applied to differentiate the teams.
 - a. Goal average will determine teams for playoffs. $\text{Numbers of goals scored} / \text{Number of goals against} \times 100 = \% \text{ (to two decimal places)}$.
 - b. If after ranking teams according to goal average to two (2) decimal places, teams remain tied, the results of the match between the two (2) teams concerned during the preliminary rounds will decide the winner.
 - c. If the two (2) teams drew their match or won one (1) match each, or if more than two (2) teams have the same number of points and percentage at the end of the preliminary rounds, then goal difference will be applied (the difference between goals for and goals against).
 - d. In the event of a further tie, the team scoring the most goals during the preliminary round will secure the higher-ranking position.
 - e. If the teams are still at a further tie, the team with the biggest margin of victory in a single match throughout the preliminary round against any of their opponents will decide the winner.
 - f. In the event of a further tie, a coin toss will decide the winner.
 - g. There will be a Managers & Umpires meeting prior to the games at 7:30am in front of the clubhouse.
