VISION AND PURPOSE

The Vicki Wilson Championship is the premier netball competition for secondary schools across Queensland. The aim of this competition is to offer a platform for boys and girls in secondary school (Years 7-12) with the opportunity to compete within their respective school sport region in the Preliminary Rounds, and the chance to qualify for the Finals Series at Nissan Arena. Teams that progress to the Finals Series compete to be crowned Vicki Wilson Championship State Champions in their respective division; Boys, Cup or Shield.

In 2026, the Vicki Wilson Championship competition had 12 Preliminary Rounds:

- **Peninsula** held at Cairns Netball Association
- **Northern** held at Townsville City Netball Association
- **Capricornia (North)** held at Mackay Netball Association
- **Capricornia (South)** held at Capricorn Coast Netball Association
- **Wide Bay** held at Bundaberg Netball Association
- **Sunshine Coast** held at Sunshine Coast Netball Association
- **Darling Downs & South West** held at Toowoomba Netball Association
- **Metropolitan North** held at Downey Park Netball Association
- **Metropolitan West** held at Western Districts Netball Association
- **Metropolitan East** held at Underwood Park Netball Association
- **South Coast (North)** held at Pimpama United Netball Association
- **South Coast (South)** held at South Coast Netball Association

A total of 2,763 matches were played during the Preliminary Rounds.

Across the State in 2026:

- 678 Teams competed from 272 Schools
 - Boys Open Championship: 125 teams
 - Cup Championship: 144 teams
 - Cup Development: 114 teams
 - Shield Championship: 143 teams
 - Shield Development: 152 teams
- Approximately 8,136 players took the court during the Preliminary Rounds.

COMPETITION MANUAL

For all rules and competition information, please read the 2026 Vicki Wilson Championship Finals Series Competition Manual.

TEAM SHEETS

- Final team lists are required by COB Thursday 23 July, 2026. Changes can be made until 30-minutes before the first game has been played by the team. Any team list changes after the 23 July must include explanation as to why the player can no longer participate. Any changes prior to the day of the competition must be sent to competitions@netballq.org.au, and any changes made on the day of the competition must be notified at the competition/administration office. Team list may include no more than 12 players for the Finals Series.
- Team lists may be shared to all Schools competing in the Finals Series in the lead up to the competition, including full player, coach, and manager names as per the team lists submitted.

ROLLING SUBSTITUTIONS

Vicki Wilson Championship Finals Series will utilise rolling substitution.

- The substitutions zone will occur in front of the team bench.
- The substitute player must stand wholly inside their team's substitute zone to indicate a substitution is to take place.
- The incoming player must wait until the player being replaced enters the substitution box before entering the field of play.
- Teams will be allowed to make substitutions during play, this includes during stoppages and intervals. There is no limit to the number of substitutions that can be made, and more than one substitution may be made at any time. Play will not be held up for substitutions.
- Players must observe the offside rules when entering the court.

PHOTO AND VIDEO CONSENT

- Netball Queensland may use images and videos from the competition for promotional purposes. Along with this, Netball Queensland will be livestreaming games over the two days.
- The University of Queensland (UQ) will be in attendance for the duration of the Finals Series and may use imagery for promotional purposes, both internally and externally, taken by their videographer during the competition.
- Consent is an opt-out requirement. Please indicate in an email to competitions@netballq.org.au if photo/video consent is not given. The deadline for this opt-out is COB Friday 31 July, 2026.
- Schools with professional photographers or using images for school purposes will need to apply for a media accreditation. If your School will have a photographer/videographer on-site during this event, they must apply for a media accreditation pass. Please email competitions@netballq.org.au for the application form. Only approved photographers will be permitted at this event.

MANAGER'S MEETING

- A Manager's Meeting will be held prior to the event to update teams of any changes and answer questions. This session will be online via Microsoft Teams (an invite will be sent to each School contact):
 - **Tuesday 4 August, 4pm**
- The meeting will be recorded, and the recording and presentation slides will be sent to all competing Schools.

FINALS SERIES FORMAT

- Teams in the Cup and Shield division will be seeded and placed into four (4) pools by Netball Queensland prior to the Finals Series. Teams in the Boys division will be seeded and placed into two (2) pools by Netball Queensland prior to the Finals Series. Seeding will be determined by the position the Region finished in the Finals Series the previous year, along with Preliminary Round results. Adjustments may be made to ensure two (2) teams from the same Region are not in the same pool.

UMPIRES

- National Badged umpires will be supplied by Netball Queensland for all matches in the Finals Series.
 - The Vicki Wilson Championship Finals Series serves as a critical step in the Netball Queensland umpiring pathway. Umpires have been appointed to this competition as a result of their strong performances in their respective Regional Premier Leagues. From this competition, high performing umpires will be invited to umpire at the State Titles competition later this year, where selections will be made for the 2027 HART Premier Netball League (HPNL) and Development Umpire Squad programs.
- All umpires under the age of 18 will be identified using GREEN wristbands as part of Netball Queensland's initiative to encourage people to be more aware of their behaviour to and around minors, and foster a safe sporting environment.

SCORING AND TIMING

- Bench officials will be supplied by Netball Queensland for all matches in the Finals Series. Central timing will be run through the Show Court (Court 8). Games will be scored using LiveScoring on Netball Connect.

APPEALS, PROTESTS, DISPUTES, AND COMPLAINTS

- All matters pertaining to an umpires ruling are not subject to appeal as per Rule 4 of World Netball's [Rules of Netball \(2024 Edition\)](#) – The decision of the umpires shall be final as they are in charge of the game, and decisions shall be given without appeal.
- A protest or complaint must be submitted to the competitions office, to be investigated by Netball Queensland. Only a School Representative/School Official may lodge Protests and Complaints.
- Should a protest or complaint relate to a single match, such protest must be lodged within one (1) hour of the conclusion of the match.

VENUE INFORMATION

TEAM TENTS

- Teams may bring tents/marquees to set-up on the outside plaza area to create a space to relax between games. TENTS MUST BE WEIGHTED - teams must supply their own weights. Chairs and other equipment within the space will NOT be provided, so please bring your own.
- Tents on the outside plaza area are 'first in, best dressed', and if there is no room outside, Schools are to sit within the grandstands surrounding the Show Court.
- Tents may NOT be set-up on the Wednesday prior to the competition, however Schools may drop-off their tents to be kept in the venue overnight.
- It is recommended players remain outside, or in the GREY seating (grandstands) surrounding the Show Court when they are not playing.

WARM-UP ZONE

- There will be a dedicated warm-up zone on the middle level (P1) of the multistorey carpark.
- Teams are permitted to start warming up when the venue opens at 7:00am.
- Teams MUST have a coach and/or manager supervising during warm-up.
- Warm-up is NOT permitted on the concourse outside the entrance of the venue or in front of Centre Management.

SPECTATORS

- Spectators are welcome to view the games. However, we request they vacate the court areas immediately after the game to allow for a smooth transition for the next group of spectators to enter.
- For the safety of the players, officials and spectators, please do not block any walkways and take your bags/chairs with you as you move around the venue.
- Free parking is available on-site, however please be aware that the venue is also home to a Park 'n' Ride and spaces are limited.

SPRAYS AND OILS

- Hair spray on shoes creates damage to surfaces and courts. Hair spray is prohibited from being used for this purpose at the Finals Series - penalties will occur to anyone breaching this rule.
- If you require spray before taping, please use in outside spaces only.
- Along with this, please do not utilise any moisturing oils as they damage the courts.

FOOD

- Nissan Arena has on-site catering. Schools may pre-order food from Courtside Brew cafe. As part of the terms and conditions of the venue, food brought into the venue must be for personal consumption only. Commercially packaged products and bulk catering is strictly prohibited.

WATER

- Water fountains are available for all patrons to use within the venue. Water drums will also be available on level 1 surrounding the upper-level courts for players and officials.

AMENITIES

- Changeroom facilities and toilets are located on level 1 in Nissan Arena.
- Schools and teams are NOT permitted to enter facilities on either ends of the Show Court. Entrance to the Show Court is via the grandstands ONLY.

EVENT INFORMATION

FIRST AID

- First Aid will be on-site throughout the duration of the Finals Series. The First-Aid locations are included on the Venue Map in [Appendix 1](#).

PHYSIO AND STRAPPING

- Complimentary strapping will be available at the Finals Series, however tape MUST be provided by players. HART Sport will also have tape available for purchase during the event. Strappers will be available during the following times:
 - Day 1: 7:00am to 1:30pm
 - Day 2: 7:00am to 11:00am

ICE

- Ice will be available for First Aid-related injuries ONLY. Schools may bring their own ice if they wish - ice will not be available for purchase on-site.

EQUIPMENT

- Netball Queensland will provide match balls for each court. The match balls are to remain on the court. It is the responsibility of the School to bring warm-up balls and two (2) sets of playing bibs.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

- This venue is used as a Park 'n' Ride.
- Traffic Management will be on-site during the event.
- School Bus Parking will be located in P4 - please email competitions@netballq.org.au by COB Friday 24 July if your School requires on-site bus parking during this event.
- There will be a dedicated warm-up zone on the middle level (P1) of the multistorey carpark.
- General Public Parking will be in P1.

OTHER KEY INFORMATION

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS

- Presentations will start 15-minutes after the last matches conclude on Friday 7 August. Medal presentations may be delayed if extra-time is required in Grand Final/Third place games.
- Winners in all division will win the Cup/Shield for their School.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in all divisions will receive a smaller shield to keep at their School.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in all divisions will receive medals.

TRAVEL SUBSIDIARY

- No travel subsidiary will be given to regional teams.
- All athletes and coaches are eligible to apply for the Local Sporting Champions grant. More information can be found [here](#).
- Netball Queensland will also apply for the Vicki Wilson Championship - Finals Series to be added to the Emerging Athlete Pathways. The funding is dependant on their approval and NQ will advise if the application is approved. More information can be found [here](#).

- Teams in the Cup and Shield division have been seeded and placed into four (4) pools. Teams in the Boys division have been seeded and placed into two (2) pools. Seeding is determined by the position the Region finished in the Finals Series the previous year, along with Preliminary Round results. Adjustments have been made to ensure two (2) teams from the same Region are not in the same pool.
- Each team will play a round-robin competition format, playing each team in their pool once.
- There will be no injury time. If an injury occurs, time will not be held, and the player will be required to leave the court as quickly and safely as possible. In the event of an emergency, or if an injured player is unable to be removed from the court, Netball Queensland will determine the best course of action based on the situation.
- If due to unforeseen and/or exceptional circumstances a match is abandoned, the following regulations shall apply:
 - If at least 50% of the match is unable to be played, each team will be given one (1) competition point, and no for and against will be awarded.
 - If 50% or more of the match is able to be played, the score will be considered final, and for and against will be awarded.

Teams will be ranked within their pool at the end of Day 1. This will be based on the following:

- Points from the pool rounds.
- If two (2) teams have equal points at the conclusion of Day 1, the final ranking of these teams shall be determined by the following method:
 - In the event of teams tying on points at the end of the pool rounds, then goal average will determine teams for playoffs. $\text{Number of goals scored/number of goals against} \times 100 = \% \text{ (to two decimal places)}$.
 - If after ranking teams according to goal average to two (2) decimal places teams remain tied, the result of the match between the two (2) teams concerned during the pool round will decide the winner.
 - If the two (2) teams drew their match or if more than two (2) teams have the same number of points and goal average at the end of the pool rounds, then goal difference will be applied (the difference between goals for and goals against).
 - In the event of a further tie, the team scoring the most goals during the pool rounds will secure the high final position.
 - If the teams are still at a further tie, the team with the biggest margin of victory in a single match during the pool rounds against any of their opponents will decide the winner.
 - In the event of a further tie, a coin toss will decide the winner.

COMPETITION STRUCTURE: DAY 2 (Friday 7th August, 2026)

PLAYOFF FORMAT

- Traditional playoff format will be used for positions 1-8, 9-12 in the Boys division.
- Traditional playoff format will be used for positions 1-8, 9-16, 17-24 in the Cup division.
- Traditional playoff format will be used for positions 1-8, 9-16, 17-20 in the Shield division.
- There will be no injury time. If an injury occurs, time will not be held, and the player will be required to leave the court as quickly and safely as possible. In the event of an emergency, or if an injured player is unable to be removed from the court, Netball Queensland will determine the best course of action based on the situation.
- If due to unforeseen and/or exceptional circumstances a match is abandoned, the following regulations shall apply:
 - If at least 50% of the match is unable to be played, each team will be given one (1) competition point, and no for and against will be awarded.
 - If 50% or more of the match is able to be played, the score will be considered final, and for and against will be awarded.

If a playoff match is drawn or abandoned with less than 50% of the match completed outside the Grand Final/Third place game, a countback will occur, with the teams being ranked based on the following:

1. Points from the pool rounds + completed final's matches (including the drawn game).
2. If the teams have equal points after the drawn finals match is included, the final ranking of these teams shall be determined by the following method:

2.1. In the event of teams tying on points at the end of the pool round and final matches, then goal average will determine teams for playoffs. $\text{Number of goals scored} / \text{Number of goals against} \times 100 = \%$ (to two decimal places)

2.2. If the two (2) teams have the same goal average to two decimal places, then goal difference will be applied (the difference between goals for and goals against).

2.3. In the event of a further tie, the team scoring the most goals during the pool rounds and final matches will secure the higher final position.

2.4. If the teams are still at a further tie, the team with the biggest margin of victory in a single match throughout the pool rounds and final matches against any of their opponents will decide the winner

2.5. In the event of a further tie, a coin toss will decide the winner.

- No draws are permitted in the Grand Final and Third place games only. If scores are tied at the conclusion of these matches, there will be a one (1) minute break to confirm scoresheet - substitutions are permitted at this time. Two four (4) minute halves will be played with a one (1) minute half-time to change sides with substitutions permitted in this time. If after extra time, the match is still drawn, the match will continue until a two (2) goal advantage is reached.

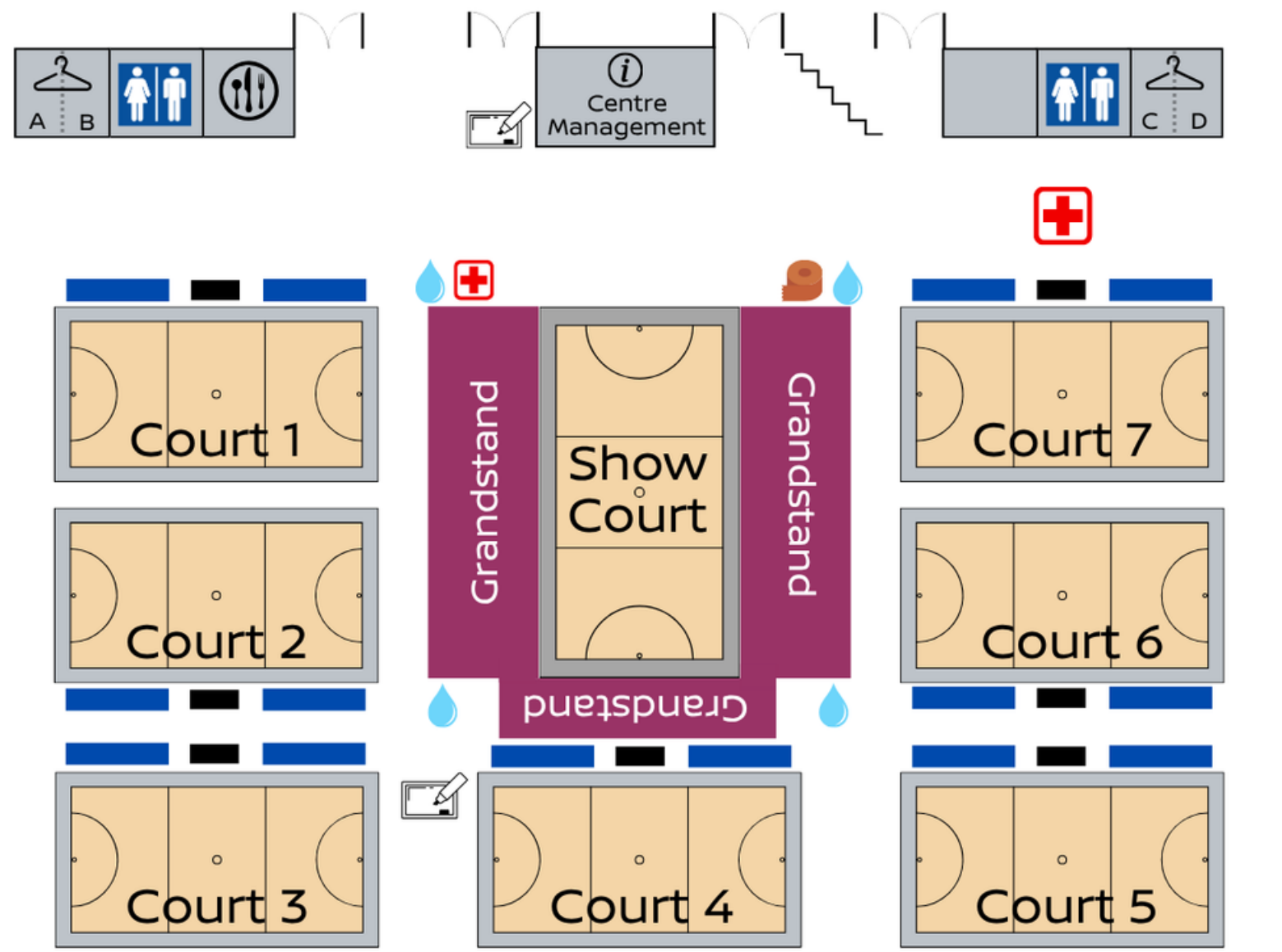

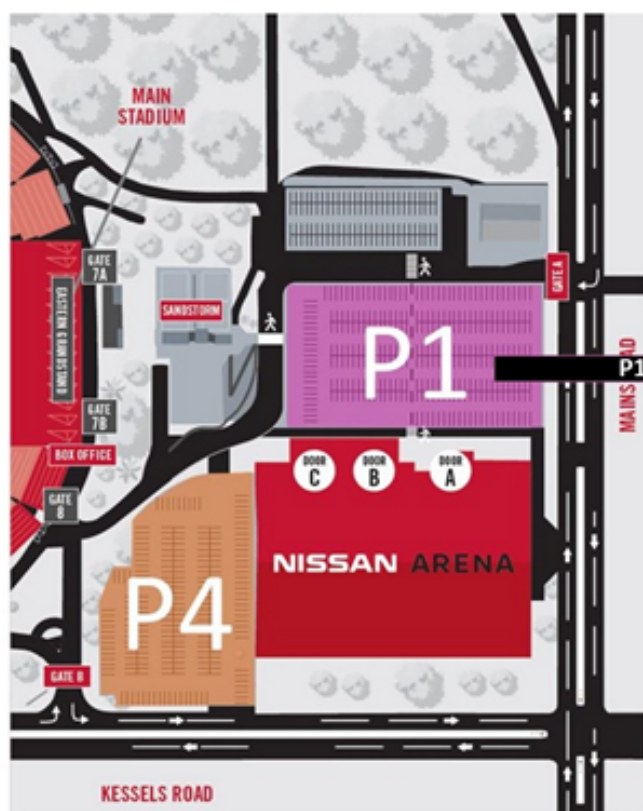

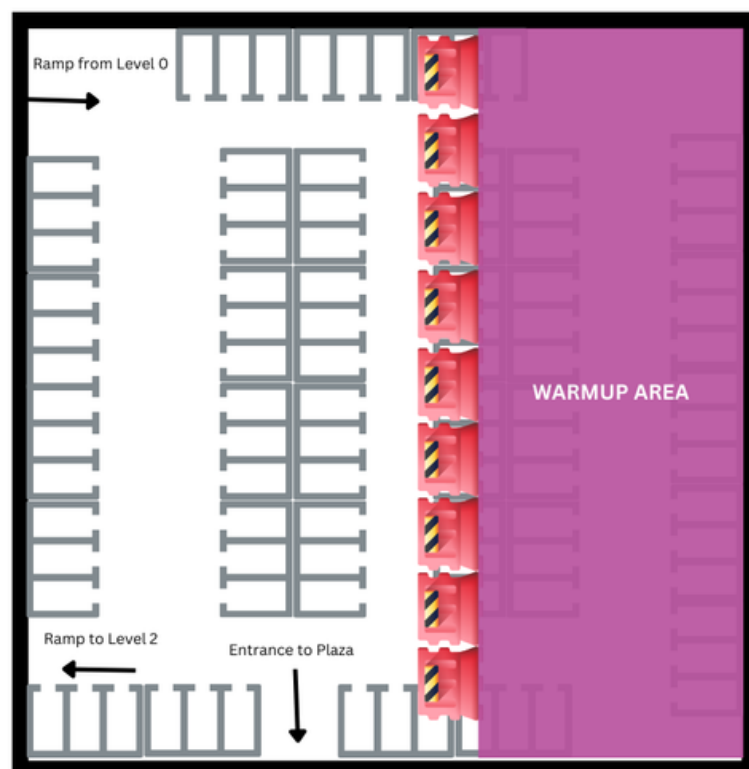
Appendix 2 - Parking Map
